

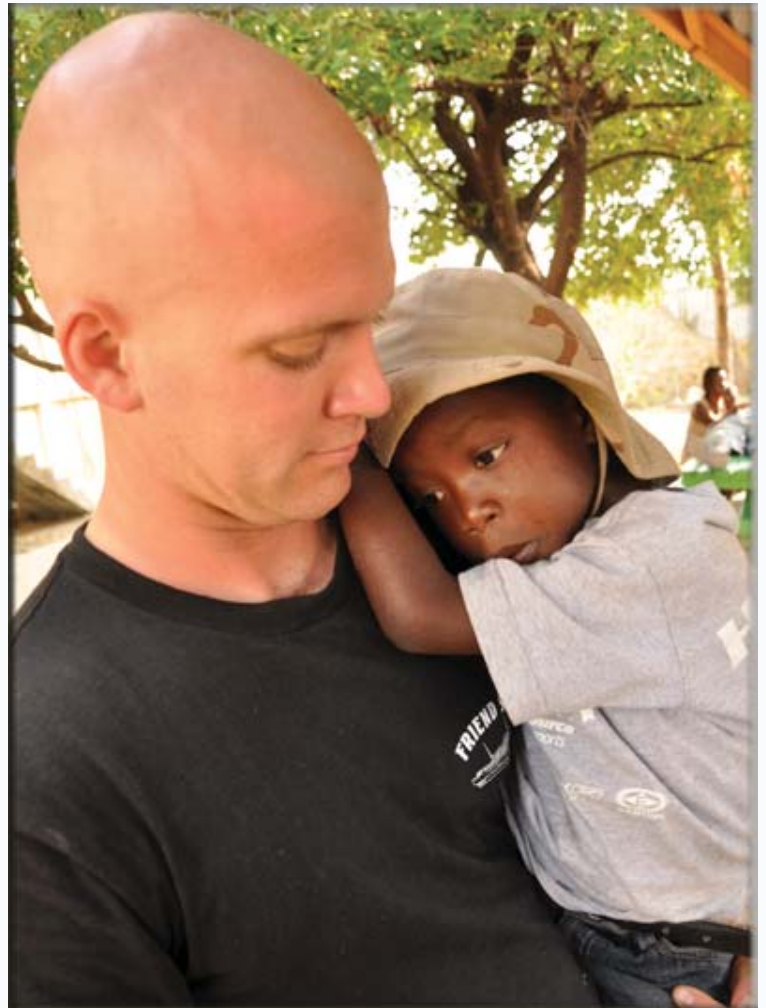

Greetings! In March, Relief Ship Integrity completed two deliveries of goods to the earthquake ravaged nation of Haiti. In early March tons of water, food and shelter materials were offloaded outside of Port-au-Prince and delivered to several organizations for distribution to those in need. Then Integrity sailed back to Miami and loaded tons of prefabricated buildings, shelter materials, food, water, clothing and personal transportation devices for disabled people. The ship returned to Haiti and our team delivered these items to ministries throughout the

earthquake zone who are working diligently to help the victims. The ship is now steaming toward Port Mercy in Lake Charles where a full load of food, clothing and shelter materials are waiting to be transported.



One of the very important commodities being distributed on each shipment brought in by Integrity is heavy duty architectural material. This has been distributed to homeless people throughout the region.

You can see in these photos some of the ways it has been used for shelter by the Haitians.



We have just completed the design for a long lasting temporary shelter built using lumber and the heavy duty fabric, pictured here with Jan Crouch, founder and director of Trinity Broadcasting Network and our partner, Smile of A Child who is lending tremendous support to the Haiti mission and arranging for all goods to be imported free of charge. Friend Ships and SOAC are planning a large production of these small homes with windows, doors and large awnings on all four sides. And as the immediate needs in Haiti shift from primarily food, water and medical supplies, we are working with wonderful ministries throughout the US who are sending in hundreds of beautiful prefabricated shelters, along with building materials, food, water and clothing.



New Design

Our team at the base camp in Haiti has been busy distributing food and tarp into the poorest communities of families left without homes by the earthquake. Those with medical skills have been involved in providing clinics to orphanages and tent cities.



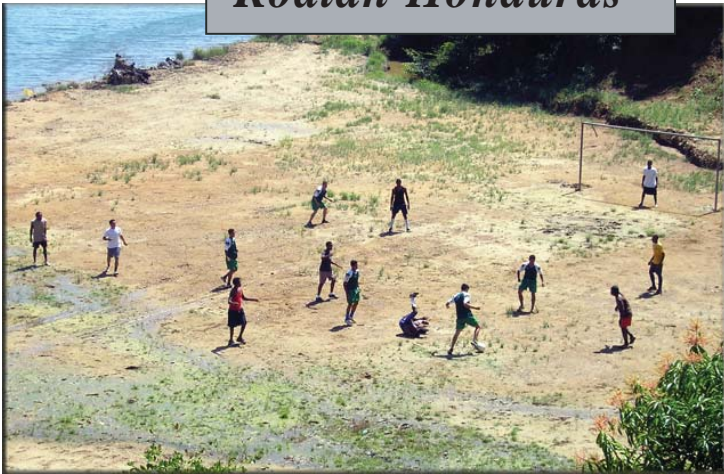
The team has also been involved in many support activities including the construction of a leach field, cutting tarp for distribution and installing razor wire around the Global Outreach compound.

In Roatán, the Pastors Association has made great progress on the soccer field we built at the Village for outreach to the local youth. They have installed goals and planted grass. Hundreds of soccer uniforms and shoes have been distributed and the first two exciting games have taken place! We look forward to this program growing and developing into an effective outreach to the youth of the community. With crime on the rise, the Village is presently hosting a Special Forces elite crime division who has been sent in from the mainland by the newly elected Mayor to assist local law enforcement in establishing a higher level of security for the islanders.

PORT MERCY

The Port Mercy team has been working hard to support the Haiti operations. A very full warehouse holds tons of supplies ready to be loaded and shipped on Integrity's current mission. We have also completed work on several Medical Super Clinics, mobile housing units, and mobile shower and toilet facilities for use in the missions.
